- PDFs of at least one and no more than three peer-reviewed publications on the disorder on which you are an author
- Other experience that you or your group have with this disorder, or why this disorder would be important to have as a *GeneReview*

The *GeneReviews* Editors will review all offers – considering our mission and the chapters already in process – and respond by email within one to three weeks.
