



# **Drug Levels and Effects**

### Summary of Use during Lactation

Limited information indicates that fosfomycin produces low levels in milk and is unlikely to be absorbed well by the infant because of the binding to calcium in the milk.[1] It is unlikely to cause any adverse effects in breastfed infants.

### **Drug Levels**

*Maternal Levels*. After 1 to 2 grams of fosfomycin given by injection, colostrum levels in 2 women were 4.8 mg/L and milk levels were 3.6 mg/L.[2,3] Further details of the studies were not given.
