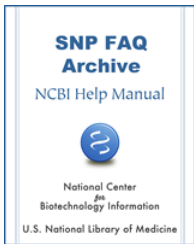

Is it possible to ID mtDNA haplogroups using dbSNP?

dbSNP cannot ID mtDNA haplogroups, but there is a group in Korea (Yonsei University) that released a website called [mtDNAmanager](#) which includes the ability to haplogroup samples. They use a simple method of comparing the submitted sequence to a list of haplogroup motifs, so reversion at particular sites are somewhat ignored. However, all of the haplogroup motifs are searchable and compiled in a .pdf file on the website. **(02/04/08)**
